

John 9:25


One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!

Proverbs 16:18


Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

Matthew 7:24


Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.


I Samuel 1:27I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him.




Exodus 20:3


You shall have no other gods before me.


Luke 15:6Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.

Dear God, thank You for loving us and never giving up on us. Help us to remember how valuable we are to You and to come back to You when we wander away. Amen.




Mark 10:14


Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.




Joshua 6:16 Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!
