Day 7: Spreading Joy to Others

Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, but those who plan peace have joy. **Proverbs 12:20**

Insight: Planning peace and spreading joy are acts of love that align with God's desires for us. When we aim to bring peace, our actions can lead to joy both in ourselves and in others.

Self-reflection: How can you be a bearer of joy today? What actions can you

take to create peace in your interactions?			



Day 8: The Strength Found in Joy

The joy of the Lord is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10

Insight: Joy is not only a comfort but also a source of strength. It fuels us, giving us the energy to face life's challenges with a hopeful heart.
