# Key Scriptures

**2 Corinthians 10:5** - We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

**Colossians 2:8 -** See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.

# Understanding New Age and New Thought

#### **Overview of New Age Beliefs**

The New Age movement is characterized by a diverse and eclectic blend of eastern and western spiritual traditions, infused with elements of mysticism, astrology, and holistic thinking. Key characteristics include:

- Personal Spiritual Growth: Unlike the communal worship and doctrine of Christianity, New Age beliefs promote personal spiritual enlightenment through practices like meditation, yoga, and channeling. Salvation and truth are seen as highly individualized and subjective.
- **Syncretism:** This is the practice of blending different religious and spiritual beliefs. New Agers may incorporate elements from Buddhism, Hinduism, Gnosticism, and even aspects of Christianity, creating a personalized faith that often strays far from biblical teachings.
- **Common Practices:** These may include astrology, the use of crystals for healing, energy practices such as Reiki, and a belief in a spiritual hierarchy of ascended masters and spiritual guides.

# Understanding New Age and New Thought

#### **Overview of New Thought Principles**

Originating in the 19th century, New Thought shares some similarities with New Age in terms of its focus on the mind's power but is more structured in its approach to spirituality and often identifies more closely with Christianity. Its core beliefs include:

- Law of Attraction: This is the belief that positive or negative thoughts bring positive or negative experiences into one's life. This concept is often used to explain personal success or failure purely by the quality of one's thoughts.
- **Divine Humanity:** New Thought proposes that divinity resides within each person, and each person's true self is inherently divine. This leads to the belief that individuals can manifest their own reality and salvation through positive thinking and self-awareness.
- Healing through Faith and Mind: Emphasis is placed on the idea that mental states can directly affect physical reality, including health. Prayer in New Thought often resembles affirmative thinking or declarations that align the universe to one's desires.
- Relationship with Christian Thought: While it uses much Christian terminology and scripture, New Thought reinterprets these according to its own metaphysical framework, often leading to conclusions that stand in contrast to traditional Christian doctrine, such as the nature of sin, salvation, and the character of God.

#### The Sovereignty of God

#### **Scripture Affirming God's Authority**

- 5 I am the Lord, and there is no other; apart from me there is no God. I will strengthen you, though you have not acknowledged me,
- 6 so that from the rising of the sun to the place of its setting people may know there is none besides me. I am the Lord, and there is no other.
- 7 I form the light and create darkness, I bring prosperity and create disaster; I, the Lord, do all these things.

Isaiah 45:5-7

These verses emphasize that God alone created and controls the universe, a stark contrast to the idea that humans can control or manifest reality through their thoughts or spiritual practices. New Age practices often idolize the creation (the universe, energy) rather than worshiping the Creator.

#### The Nature of Truth

In a world where relative truths prevail, especially in New Age and New Thought, the Bible provides absolute truths that are unchanging and reliable.

#### **Biblical Perspective on Truth**

6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 14:6

This declaration asserts that truth is not a set of ideas to be discovered through personal enlightenment but a person to be followed and worshipped.

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

The Bible should be the Christian's ultimate guide in discerning truth from deception, providing clear guidance and correction.
