#### Day 1: Introduction to Prayer

One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples." Luke 11:1

#### Day 4: Your Kingdom Come

He said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Luke 11:2

Jesus teaches his followers to ask for forgiveness for their own sins, but also to acknowledge their responsibility to forgive others who have wronged them. This concept emphasizes the interconnectedness of forgiveness and acknowledges that as we seek forgiveness from God, we must extend that same forgiveness to others. When we ask God for forgiveness, we are acknowledging our own failings and the need for grace, and in turn, we are called to offer that same grace to those who have wronged us.

Reflection: Who do you need to forgive today? How can you cultivate a heart of forgiveness?

Lord, forgive me for my sins and help me to forgive others as You have forgiven me. Create in me a clean heart. Amen.

## Day 8: The Friend at Midnight

5 Then Jesus said to them, "Suppose you have a friend, and you go to him at midnight and say, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread; 6 a friend of mine on a journey has come to me, and I have no food to offer him.' 7 And suppose the one inside answers, 'Don't bother me. The door is already locked, and my children and I are in bed. I can't get up and give you anything.' 8 I tell you, even though he will not get up and give you the bread because of friendship, yet because of your shameless audacity[a] he will surely get up and give you as much as you need. Luke 11:5-8

The parable of the friend at midnight teaches us the importance of persistence in prayer. God invites us to approach Him boldly and persistently, knowing that He hears and answers our prayers.

Reflection: How persistent are you in prayer? In what areas of your life do you need to be more persistent?

Father, give me the persistence to continue in prayer, trusting that You hear and will answer. Strengthen my faith as I wait on You. Amen.

#### Day 9: Ask, Seek, Knock

9 "So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. 10 For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. Luke 11:9-10

Jesus encourages us to ask, seek, and knock, promising that we will receive, find, and have doors opened to us. This teaching emphasizes the importance of active and persistent prayer.

Luke 11:11-13
