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Intro

If you have a blog (or a website), the most important thing is traffic.

Without traffic, every effort you make is practically useless. If you're spending your precious time writing blog posts, you want your content to be seen. Preferably by as many people as possible.

I won't lie to you: this report won't show you how to get thousands of visitors overnight. I wish it would, but unfortunately I haven't discovered the secret to that myself.

All I can do is show you how I managed to triple my traffic by using a couple of very simple tricks. These tricks are so simple, everyone can apply them – even if you are new to blogging.

It's no rocket science, but it works.

All you need are a few simple tools - most of them are completely free - and a little time to set them up.

Once you get the idea, the possibilities are endless.

I'll be showing you the basic idea – then it's up to you. You can take this system and extend it in any way you want. Use your creativity to maximize its potential, and multiply your traffic again and again and again.

The Basic Idea

The basic idea of the system I'll be showing you is to add certain elements to your blog posts which will increase traffic in various ways.

There are numerous tools and plugins that can do this on its own. I've tried many of them; some with more result than others.

Then it struck me: what would happen if I would combine a couple of the tools that I had already tested to turn them into a hands-free traffic generating system. And guess what? It worked.

It took me about an hour to collect everything I needed and set up the entire system, and that was it. Ever since, I've seen my blog traffic increase on complete autopilot. No work, no hassle, no worries.

For years I had been struggling to get people to visit my blog. If I had only known the answer was so simple...

The entire system is actually based on one simple plugin that has been around for years and is probably known by every blogger. It automatically adds content to the bottom of every post you make.

Since it allows you to add almost any kind of content, it's just a matter of making the correct decisions and adding the tools that will bring in a lot of traffic.

Getting Started

Step 1: The Basic Plugin

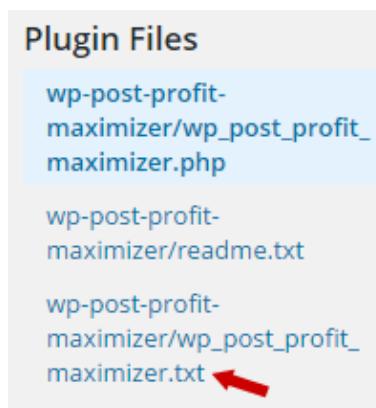
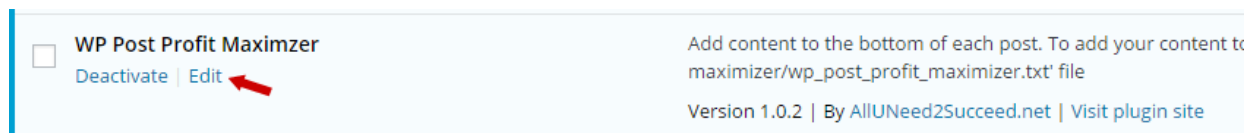
First of all, you need to download the plugin that forms the foundation of this system. It's called WP Post Profit Maximizer (AKA 'Bottom Of Every Post' plugin).

Install and activate the plugin.

Once installed, you can add any content you like to the plugin. This content will then show up at the bottom of every post you make.

To add your content, you need to click 'Edit' and make changes to the 'wp-post-profit-maximizer/wp_post-profit_maximizer.txt' file.



This is the basic text file:

The following steps will show you which content you need to add to this text file to make your blog posts generate more traffic and revenue.

Step 2: Your AdSense Ad Code

Sign in to your [Google AdSense](#) account and create an ad. Which size and layout you choose depends on the layout of your blog. I recommend using a horizontal banner. Paste your generated code into a Notepad file until you're ready to use it.

Step 3: The Social Locker Plugin

Downloading And Configuring The Plugin

Download the [Onepress Social Locker Plugin](#).

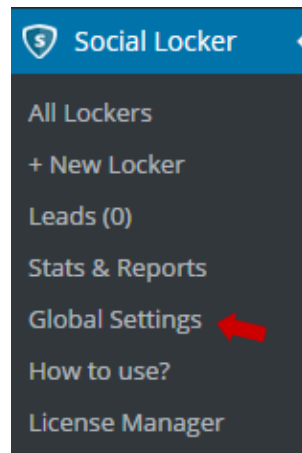
(I suggest you grab the [PRO version](#) to unlock all features)

This plugin allows you to lock content behind a set of social buttons until the visitor likes, shares, +1s or tweets your page. It helps to improve social performance of your website, get more likes/shares, build quality followers and attract more traffic from social networks.

In this system, it will be set up to seduce people into sharing your blog post in order to receive a free gift.

Upload the plugin to your blog and activate it.

Now it is time to configure the plugin, so click 'Global Settings'.



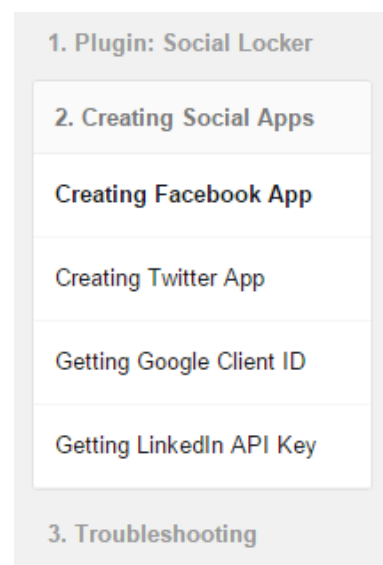
We're only going to use the 'social locker' feature.

You'll notice you'll need to create a Facebook App ID, a Twitter API Key and a Google Client ID.

No worries, the plugin provides all the info you need to be able to set these up.

Just click on 'How To Use' in the menu, then click '2. Creating Social Apps'. Everything is explained step by step.

Once you've created your codes, add them to the provided fields under the 'Social Locker' tab on the 'Global Settings' page and click 'Save Changes'.

Adding Incentives To The Plugin

The goal of using the plugin is to get people to share your blog post. To get them to do this, you'll be offering them a reward once they've shared your post.

So the first thing you need to do is collect a good number of products with giveaway rights.

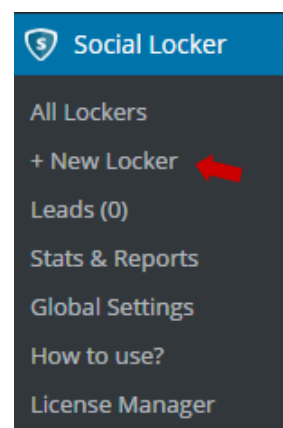

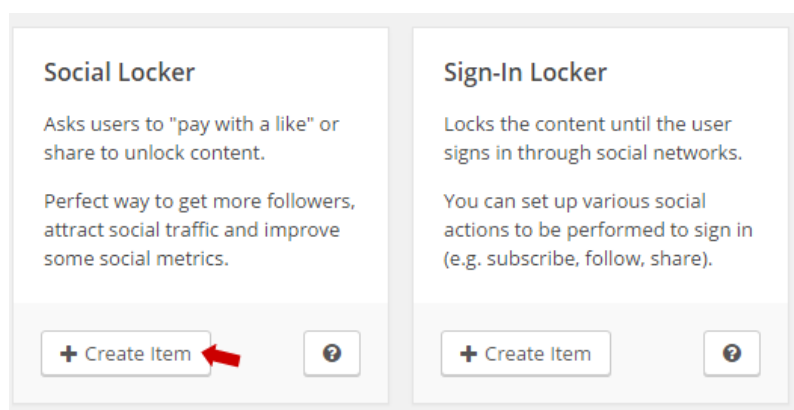
Once you've collected a good number of products, it is time to load them into the Social Locker plugin.

To do this, click 'New Locker' in the admin panel.



Creating Your Social Lockers

Then, create a new social locker.



Set the basic options.

Locker Header: 'Get #Product Name# For FREE!'

Locker Message: 'To Download This Special Gift for free, please share this page through one of the buttons below.'

Depending on the version you have (free or pro), you can choose a custom theme for your locker.

Make sure you set the 'Overlap mode' to 'Full'.

Locker header
Get 'Essential Twitter Techniques (MRR)' For FREE!
Type a header which attracts attention or calls to action. You can leave this field empty.

Locker message
Type a message which will appear under the header.
Shortcodes: [post_title], [post_url].

Theme
Secrets
Select the most suitable theme.

Overlap Mode
Full (classic) Transparency Blurring
Choose the way how your locker should lock the content.

The 'Locker message' field contains a rich text editor with the following content: 'To download this report with MRR for free, please share this page through one of the buttons below.'


Underneath, you can select the social options. If you're using the free version of the plugin you can only choose between 3 social buttons: Facebook Like, Twitter Tweet, Google +1. I did upgrade my copy because I thought there was more value in a Facebook & Google Share than in the available Facebook Like and G+1 option.


As you can see in the picture below, [the PRO version](#) gives you access to 8 different social buttons to choose from.



Set On, to activate the button.

URL to tweet

Set an URL which the user has to tweet in order to unlock your content. Leave this field empty to use an URL of the page where the locker will be located.

Tweet

Type a message to tweet. Leave this field empty to use default tweet (page title + URL). Also you can use the shortcode [post_title] in order to insert automatically a post title into the tweet.

Optional. Checks whether the user actually has tweeted or not. Requires the user to authorize the BizPanda app.

Optional. Screen name of the user to attribute the Tweet to (without @).

Button Title

Optional. A title of the button that is situated on the covers in the themes "Secrets" and "Flat".

Simply choose the buttons you want to use and activate them.

You can leave the URL fields empty, since you want your visitors to share the page the locker is displayed on.

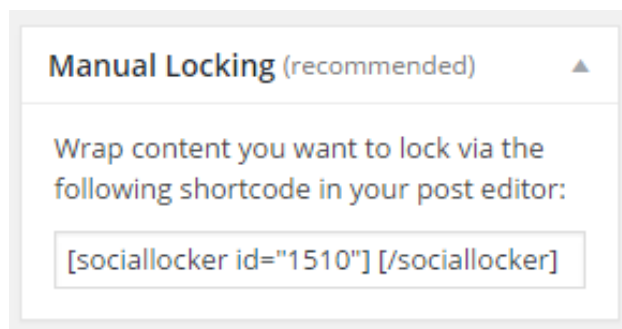
On the right side, you have some more options you can set.

Make the locker reappear after 1 day and make sure you set the 'Mobile' switch to 'On'.

Leave the 'Hide For members' switch set to 'Off'.

You can leave the other settings as they are.

In the top right corner, you'll find your manual locking code for that incentive.



Copy the shortcode and paste it into Notepad. Be sure to note down the name of the product this short code belongs to, because you'll need it later.

Create a different locker for each giveaway product you have. Copy each shortcode and paste it into your Notepad file, together with the name of the product.

Step 4: Uploading Your Giveaway Products

Create a folder on your server to which you can upload your giveaway products. Make sure the name of the folder is hard to guess, and add an empty index.html file to it. (This file will prevent the uploaded files to be shown in case someone manages to guess the folder name.)

Upload all your products to it.

For extra protection, I always add a random number to the end of each file name, so the files are harder to find. (For example: twittertechniques546.zip)

Step 5: Getting Your Ad Exchange Codes

Ad/traffic exchange sites will bring in extra traffic, if you use them correctly. If you want to find out how to make the most out of them, be sure to read the Set And Forget Money System Guide. ([Download here](#)).

To be able to promote your sites through these traffic exchanges, you need to earn credits. The sites listed below offer you the opportunity to earn credits on autopilot, since they provide a code you can put on your website to display banner or text ads from other members. Every time these ads are displayed, you'll be earning credits you can use to promote your own sites.

Simply sign up for the sites using the links below. Set up your profile, and add your ads. (Be sure to read the *Set And Forget Money System Guide* I mentioned earlier!)

Then, look for the code or widget you can use to earn credits. (The place where you can find these codes is different for every site. Just take a look around – they're not difficult to find.)

Copy these codes and paste them into another Notepad file.

Note:

If you don't believe in the power of traffic/ad exchange sites, make sure you read the report I mentioned above (Set And Forget Money System Guide).

Then decide whether you want to use them or not.

When you decide not to, you can simply replace these codes with affiliate ads. Go find a collection of affiliate links and the according banner ads (468x60 works best) for in-demand products (preferably products that aren't limited in time), and once you reach step 3 of the next chapter, simply replace the traffic exchange code with your banner ad code.

(Be sure to read section b of step 3 in the next chapter – I'll show you how you can make those affiliate banners responsive.)

Setting Up The Ads

Step 1: Installing the AdRotate Plugin

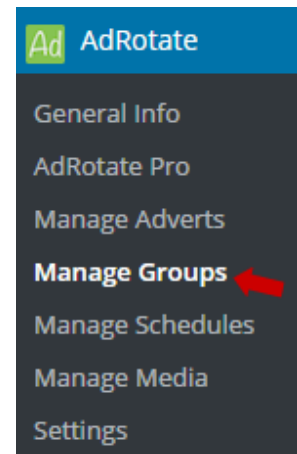
Download the [AdRotate Plugin](#).

Unzip the file, because there are some bonuses provided next to the plugin .zip file.

Upload adrotate.3.15.2.zip and activate it.

The AdRotate plugin will rotate all ads and social locker incentives you add to it, so your visitors will get to see different ads and giveaway products in every post. This increases the chance that they are going to share your posts.

In the admin panel click 'Manage Groups'.



Step 2: Creating Ad Groups

You'll need to create 2 different groups:

- One for your ad codes (Name it 'Bottom Posts')
- One for your Social Locker codes (Name it 'Downloads')

Set the block size to 1 row and 1 column and the advert size to 'auto'.

Step 3: Adding Ad Codes


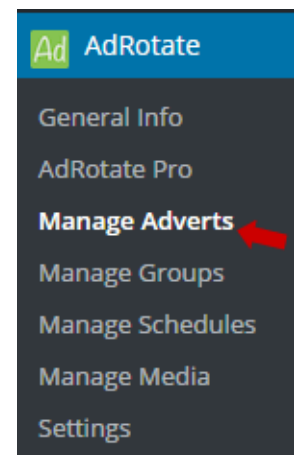
A. Traffic/Ad Exchange Codes

First, you're going to add all the codes you gathered from the traffic exchange sites.

To do so, click 'Manage Adverts'.


Click 'Add New'.

Give your ad a name (e.g. 'ViralAdsUnleashed Text Ads') and paste the code into the AdCode field.

Further down, you can decide to schedule your advert. This would be useful if you want to ad ads for products that will expire at a certain date, but in this case we don't want the ads to expire, so make sure you set an end date that is in a far future.

Scroll down to the bottom of the page and check the box next to the group you want to add the ad to.

Repeat these steps for every ad code you've gathered.

B. Adding Responsive Affiliate Ads

If you don't want to use traffic/ad exchange codes, you can replace them by simple affiliate image ads. The AdRotate plugin allows you to make those banners responsive. Let me show you how:

- Go to the AdRotate 'Settings' page. Under the 'General' tab, scroll down until you see 'Banner Folder'. You can keep the standard name or rename the folder.
- Click 'Update' to save.
- Upload your banner images to the banner folder.


To set up your ads:

- Click 'Manage Adverts'.
- Click 'Add New'.
- Give your ad a name (preferably the name of the product you'll be promoting) and paste the banner code into the AdCode field.

This code will look like this:

- Select the banner from your ad from the 'Banner folder' dropdown list.

- Now go back to the 'Add code' field and replace the URL to your banner image with %image%

- Now scroll down to the 'Advanced' section and tick the box 'Enable responsive support' for this advert'.
- Scroll down and make sure the dropdown box next to 'Activate' is set to 'Yes, this ad will be used'.



- Further down, you can decide to schedule your advert. This would be useful if you want to ad ads for products that will expire at a certain date, but in this case we don't want the ads to expire, so make sure you set an end date that is in a far future.

- Save the ad.
- Repeat these steps for every affiliate ad you want to add.

Note:

Below, I'll be showing you how to add those ads to the footer of every post you make. If you want to increase your revenue even more, you can also use the AdRotate plugin to add rotating affiliate ads to your sidebar.

Simply make a separate group for 'Sidebar ads' and add your ads as described above. Don't forget to add them to the 'Sidebar ads' group you've created.

Once you've added all ads, go back to the group settings and scroll down to 'Usage'. There you can choose whether you want to use the AdRotate widget or simply paste the group short code in a text widget.

Step 4: Adding Social Lockers

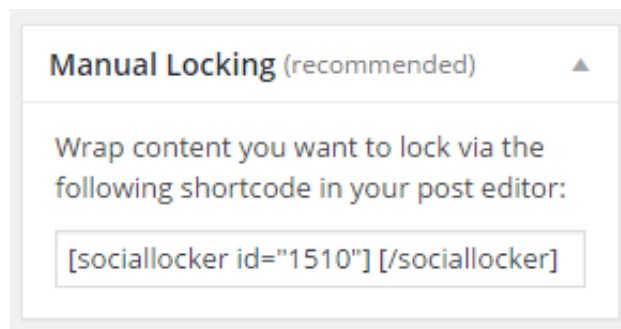
Now it is time to add your social lockers.

Again, click 'Add New'.

Give your ad a title (e.g. #Product Name Download#).

In the AdCode field, you'll need to add paste the social locker code you acquired for that product.

Remember?




In between the 2 parts of the shortcode, you'll need to add your thank you-message and your download link for your incentive.

Here's an example:

Again, make sure you activate the ad, and set the date.

At the bottom, check the checkbox next to the 'Downloads' group.

Step 5: Adding Your AdSense Ad


You don't need to create a separate group for your AdSense ad (unless you want to rotate different ad sizes).

Simply create a new ad. Name it 'AdSense'.


Paste your AdSense ad code in the AdCopy field.

Activate the ad and set the date.

Copy the shortcode and paste it into the same Notepad file you used to take note of the ad group shortcodes.

Adding Everything To The WP Post Profit Maximizer Plugin

Once you've got everything set up, it is time to wrap it up.

In your Notepad file, you should have gathered 3 shortcodes.

Ad group 1 (Bottom posts).

It will look something like this: [adrotate group="1"]

Ad group 2 (Social Locker Downloads).

It will look something like this: [adrotate group="2"]

Ad Banner 1 (Adsense ad)

It will look something like this: [adrotate banner="11"]

All that's left is adding these shortcodes to the 'wp-post-monetizer/bottom_of_every_post.txt' file.

It is a good idea to add a call-to-action before pasting the shortcodes, to let people know they can find something interesting below your post.

Here's what my 'wp-post-monetizer/bottom_of_every_post.txt' file looks like:

Extra: Promote Your Tweets

Another idea is to promote your Twitter tweets by using the WP Tweet Rotator plugin . [You can download this plugin here.](#)

Unzip the downloaded file. Inside you'll find a bonus file and the wp-tweet-rotator.zip file. Upload this wp-tweet-rotator.zip file to your Wordpress site.

Simply follow the tutorial on how to set up a Twitter application and get the tweet rotator running.

Then, add your personalized shortcode to your 'wp-post-monetizer/bottom_of_every_post.txt' file. Once you've done this, your tweets will be rotated at the bottom of your post.

Shortcode: **[rotatingtweets screen_name='your_twitter']**

You can also use this plugin to add a rotating tweets widget to your sidebar.

More Ideas

This system is absolutely not limited to the ideas I've mentioned in this report. The beauty of the WP Post Profit Maximizer Plugin is that it allows you to add any content you like to be shown at the bottom of your posts.

It allows you to add HTML-code, JavaScript code, any plugin short code, even embeddable flash game codes,...

You can extend this system in any way you like.

Here are a couple more examples of ways you can benefit from this system:

Extra Traffic Tools

Below, you'll find a list of tools that will also help you to boost traffic. It's impossible to list all of them, but I thought I'd let you know which ones have been giving me great results.

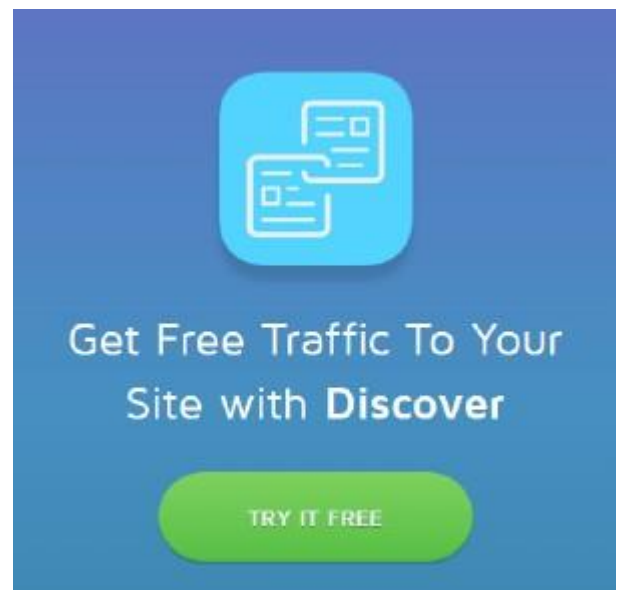
[SumoMe Plugin](#) (FREE)

SumoMe is a suite of free tools that can be used to grow your website's traffic. They offer several tools that can help you to grow your blog or website traffic.

The one I use in combination with the system I've been describing in this report is the 'Discovery' feature.

Discovery adds a grid of 4 to 24 recommendations at the end of your article, or a scroll box that pops up with a highly-focused "read next" article.

This way you connect to 150,000+ other SumoMe sites to send more free traffic your way. Other SumoMe sites promote your content on their sites, and you promote new content for your visitors on your site.



You earn credits when people click on Discover links at the end of your articles. You can then use those credits to get more traffic from other people's sites.

SumoMe also offers a tool called 'Image Sharer'. This tool adds social share buttons to your images, which makes it dead simple for your readers to auto-magically share the images on your site and link back to you, driving you viral traffic!

[WP Content Discovery](#) is a FREE Wordpress plugin that works in the same way as the SumoMe Discover plugin.

[Pushcrew plugin](#) (FREE)

The Pushcrew plugin allows you to send notifications to your users, even when they're not on your website.

[Click To Tweet Plugin](#) (FREE)

Create clickable 'Click To Tweet' boxes in your blog posts. Social shares are only 1 click away.

[WP Tweet Machine](#)

This plugin automates your Twitter account. It grows your number of followers on autopilot, takes care of retweets and more.

[FB Traffic Monster Plugin](#)

FB Traffic Monster is a wordpress plugin that lets you generate on demand traffic by sending instant notifications on FB to ANYONE who has visited your website!

[Viral Quiz Builder Plugin](#)

Create Stunning & Viral Quizzes on your Wordpress Site. Let players share results on social media sites, and see your blog traffic increase.

[Revive Old Posts Plugin](#) (FREE)

Plugin to share about your old posts on twitter, facebook, linkedin to get more hits for them and keep them alive.
